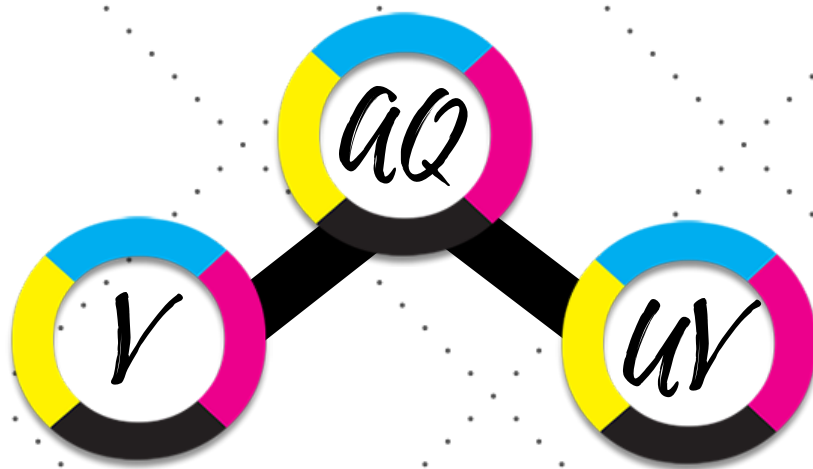

HOW TO USE COATINGS TO PROTECT YOUR PRINTING



Printing is an investment

USE COATINGS TO PROTECT HEAVY INK COVERAGE & SOLIDS FROM SCRATCHING & SCUFFING OR TO CREATE SPECIFIC DESIGN EFFECTS



Aqueous coatings are water-based and are resistant to yellowing. They have high gloss, matte and soft touch finishes. Dries immediately and creates a hard surface that protects against scratching & scuffing.



Varnishes are oil-based and applied like ink allowing for unique spots in creative designs. Varnishes may yellow over time. Gloss varnishes offers more protection than a dull varnishes.



UV coatings use a UV light to cure a polymer onto the surface of the paper. It creates a hard surface and offers the most protection against scuffing & scratching. Very high gloss finish.
